In the Iraq and Afghan wars, 5,393 U.S. soldiers, over 1.2 million Iraqis, and countless Afghans have died. 41,112 U.S. soldiers were seriously wounded. Nearly 20% of soldiers suffer from post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD).

Military spending gobbles up at least 44% of tax revenues. The two wars are the single biggest drain on the federal budget, \$1 trillion so far. They have been funded by borrowing and by our tax \$ at a **cost to each Rockland family of \$22,000 so far!**

The irony is that the wars of aggression made us less safe. Jürgen Todenhöfer, a German politician said, "**The war in Afghanistan is a breeding program for terrorists.**"
