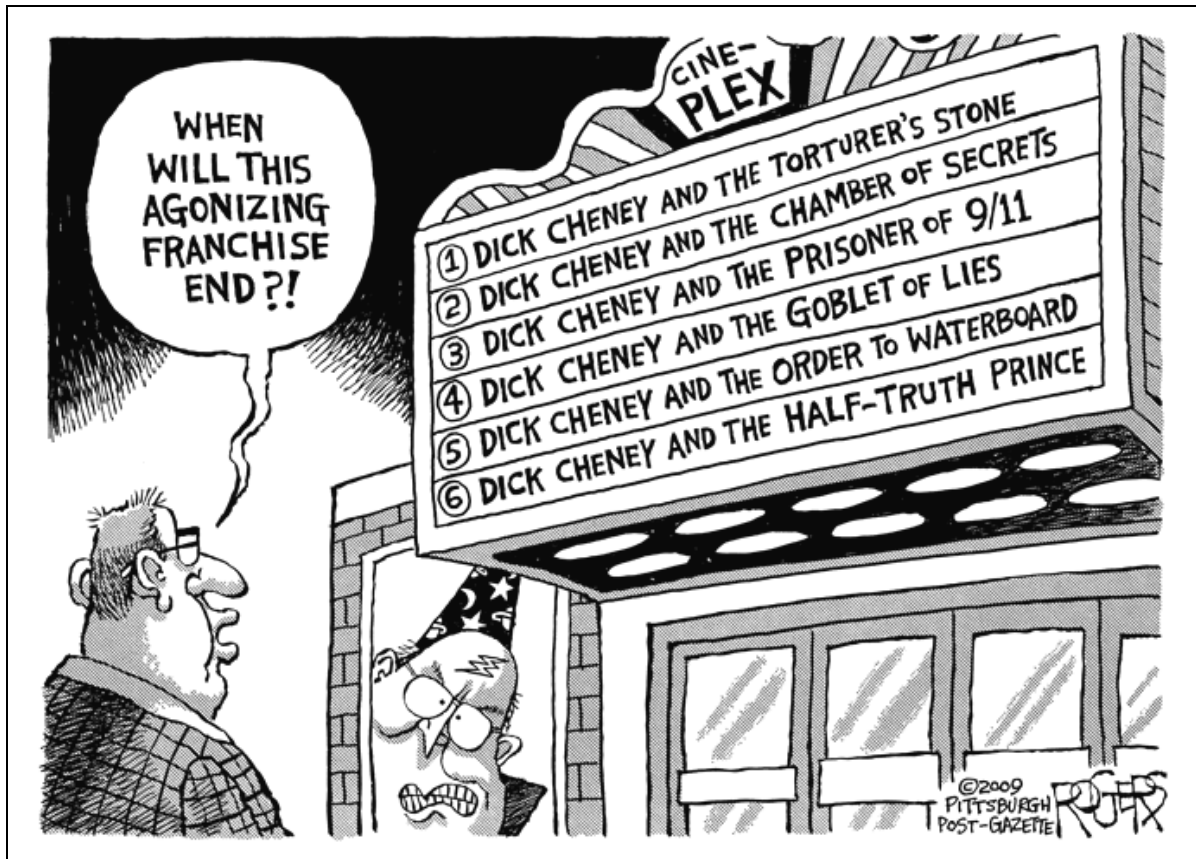

Former Vice President Dick Cheney admitted authorizing extreme interrogation techniques including “waterboarding.”

Attorney General Eric Holder said unequivocally, “**Waterboarding is torture.**” **It is illegal under the Geneva Conventions.** The Nation’s top military lawyers and legal experts across the political spectrum have condemned waterboarding as illegal. In fact, after World War II, in the International Military Tribunal, **the U.S. prosecuted and convicted Japanese war criminals for using waterboarding.**

Expert after expert agree that **torture does not provide useful intelligence** and in fact **puts our military and our country at risk.** Al Qaeda members have said that U.S. torturing of prisoners is a powerful tool for their recruiting of new members.
