WHY OCTOBER 11? On October 11, 2002 Congress approved the "Iraq War Resolution" granting the Bush administration authorization to invade Iraq, an internationally condemned act of illegal aggression.

On Saturday, October 11, 2008—exactly six years after Congress unleashed the “Shock and Awe” plan for Iraq-- we will be joining grass roots organizations across the country, during this presidential campaign period, to send a message to the war makers in Washington and to the world: We want this war to end and we want it to end NOW!

Let us remember that as recently as June 2008, Congress, in defiance of the wishes of the American people, voted to approve yet another \$162 billion in funding for the war effort.
