

Join Our 400th Peace Vigil



On July 17th, the Rockland Coalition for Peace and Justice will acknowledge our **400th consecutive weekly vigil, since 2002**

The event will be a sad one, but it will be hopeful as well. Sad, because it will focus on **the senseless tragedy of the long wars in Afghanistan and Iraq.** More than **5,400** U.S. troops and over **a million** of Iraqi and Afghan civilians have perished in these wars. Our military forces there are seen as foreign intruders, and fuel the insurgency. The **\$1 trillion** wars enrich a few merchants of death at the expense of everyone else. **The share of the war cost for every Rockland family is \$22,000 so far.**

But the event will be hopeful, too, because we vigilers, 30 strong each week and up to 300 strong on special occasions, here **every Saturday between 1 and 3 pm, rain or shine, hot or cold,** believe that voicing public disapproval and drawing attention to these wars of aggression will help end the wars.

We encourage Rocklanders to stand with us for a short while or for the 2 full hours. Together we will protest against these senseless wars and push for a fundamental change from war to peace, from greed to cooperation.
